Annual seasonal flu vaccination is now due

All children from reception to year 11 are being offered the flu vaccination in school as part of the national vaccination programme. Flu can be an unpleasant illness and make some people seriously ill. The vaccination is **free, safe and effective**. It helps to protect against seasonal flu and serious complications such as bronchitis, ear infections and pneumonia – and will also help to prevent the spread of flu and protect others who are vulnerable. There are two different types of vaccine available:

Nasal spray flu vaccine

Offers the best protection against flu. It is given as a spray squirted up each nostril. It's quick and painless. For some children the nasal spray is not suitable for medical reasons. Our team will review the medical information submitted before offering the flu vaccine injection.

The nasal vaccine contains traces of a highly processed form of porcine gelatine.

Flu vaccine injection

The injection is given into the muscle in the upper arm, which may cause soreness.

This vaccine is offered as an alternative if the nasal spray is not suitable due to medical reasons.


This vaccine does not contain porcine gelatine.

For primary school age children, we will only give your child the flu vaccination if we have your consent. Please do this as soon as possible, using the instructions below. You only need to submit your decision **once**.

How to give consent for your child to get the flu vaccination

- Make a note of the code for your school. For **Buckminster Primary School** the school code is **LE119910** and visit www.leicsandrutlandimms.co.uk or scan the QR code using your smartphone camera to go straight to the website.
- Select **Seasonal Flu** and enter the school code. On the consent declaration page you can consent for either the nasal flu vaccine **or** the injectable flu vaccine.
- You will receive a confirmation email when the form is submitted.

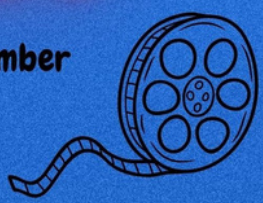

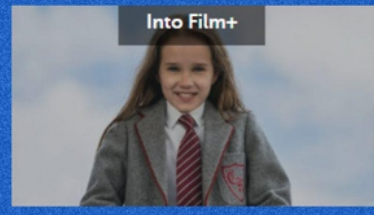
