English writing – Everyday	Our English lessons this half term is based around the book 'Romeo and Juliet' written by William Shakespeare. During the sequence, children will create their own playscripts and formal debates.

Science - Monday	In science this term we are looking at the solar system and all that it contains. We will be doing a class assembly on the solar system at the end of the term.		
Geography – Wednesday	In we will be focusing on spatial reasoning and map skills. We will also be looking at the four hemispheres and using latitude and longitude. Furthermore, we will be looking at 2 and 4 figure grid references.		

Music – Thursday	Our first topic in Music the children are looking at south African culture. Using African instruments and learning cultural dances.
PE – Wednesday and Thursday	Our first PE lesson of the week will be swimming and the second on a Wednesday will be based on cardiovascular fitness.
Computing – Monday	In computing we will be looking at databases. How they are created and why they are helpful. We will also look at internet safety.
D&T – Tuesday	In D&T the children will be designing doodle boots with integrated circuits and motors.
RSHE – Tuesday	This term we be looking at celebrating difference. This topic will include lessons on, different cultures, racism and types of bullying.
RE – Friday	This half term we will be developing our understanding of Jesus Christ and his role within Christianity. We will also be focusing on the creation story and collective forms of worship. We will also focus on the use of poetry in the bible. We will also be going on a multifaith trip to look at Hinduism in Leicester city centre.
French – Friday	This term in French we will be looking at numbers up to 31. How to ask and tell someone your birthday, as well as asking how to spell things using the alphabet.
